Dillon City Court has jurisdiction over misdemeanors, Dillon City Ordinance violations, and some civil matters alleged to have occurred within the Dillon city limits. The Court processes hundreds of citations and serves nearly 400 defendants each year.



The Court is open every day of the week from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Court sees defendants and conducts hearings five days a week. The judge conducts hearings at the Court and the Beaverhead County Detention Center.

Mondays and Fridays have designated walk-in times where no appointment is needed.

The Court is staffed by the judge and a half-time clerk of court. The Court appreciates when defendants and community members make an appointment to appear in Court or visit with the judge so that we can ensure you are given an appropriate amount of time to address your matter and receive our undivided attention.

Appearing on your citation

Appearances during OPEN COURT times do not require an appointment and defendants are seen on a first-come, first-served basis. OPEN COURT hours are on Mondays and Fridays from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

If you prefer to have a designated time for your appearance, you may make an appointment by calling the Court at 406-683-6690. The Court requests that you call the Court within five days of receiving your citation if you wish you schedule an appointment for your appearance. The date on your citation is a deadline for your action on your case, not your hearing date. **Hearings must be scheduled with the Court.**

Payment options

The City Hall accepts cash and check court payments and issues receipts during normal business hours at the City Hall front desk. After business hours, cash and check payments may be deposited into the locked payment box on the front door. Receipts for afterhours payments can be requested on the payment envelope.

Credit card payments are accepted through the www.citepayusa.com website. This website charges a small surcharge for the use of this service. Follow the steps below to make a payment online:

- Go to www.citepayusa.com
- Select Montana
- Select pay a citation, fine, or a court fee
- Select Dillon City Court
- Enter in your
-citation number (AXXXXX),
-case number (TK-155-20XX-000XXX), or
-parking ticket number (PKXXXX)
- Enter your birthdate
- Confirm ticket information
- Choose to pay the full fine or make a partial payment
- Enter credit card information

Additional services

The Court serves the community by exhibiting professionalism and respect for all who pass through our doors. The Court offers conveniences such as:

- Seek assistance with submitting their OPD application
- Seek legal information and contact information for other courts or services
